

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 07.06.2017 AT CONFERENCE HALL, CSL BUILDING, SHASTRI BHAWAN, NEW DELHI UNDER THE SCHEME "NATIONAL MISSION ON CULTURAL MAPPING AND ROADMAP".**

A meeting of Experts of Cultural Mapping of India (CMI) and other stake holders was held on 07.06.2017 at 12.00 Noon at Conference Hall, CSL Building, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairpersonship of Secretary(Culture) to discuss setting up of Mission Secretariat and modalities for carrying out Cultural Mapping activities. List of participants is annexed as Appendix-A.

2. Subsequent to welcoming all the participants, the Chairman emphasized the need of commencing the activities virtually under the Mission as the time was passing rapidly. Accordingly after discussion with the members, it was decided to kick start the national campaign for spreading cultural awareness as well as talent hunt in the country initially in five Blocks on pilot basis under the supervision of voluntary members of Cultural Mapping of India, as indicated below:-

The voluntary members were informed that while conducting the activities in the identified Blocks, as far as possible the expenditure has to be kept within Rs.3 lakh per Block so that the expenditure in any case may not exceed the ceiling of Rs.4.91 lakh per Block as prescribed under the Mission Document. It was also decided that the national campaign on Cultural Mapping of India will be launched by Hon'ble Culture Minister from the Govardhan Block on 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2017. Further, necessary assistance of State Govt. machinery (District and local administration) may be taken for maintenance of security, law & order and smooth & successfully conducting the proposed programmes.
