MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 07.06.2017 AT CONFERENCE HALL, CSL BUILDING, SHASTRI BHAWAN, NEW DELHI UNDER THE SCHEME "NATIONAL MISSION ON CULTURAL MAPPING AND ROADMAP".

A meeting of Experts of Cultural Mapping of India (CMI) and other stake holders was held on 07.06.2017 at 12.00 Noon at Conference Hall, CSL Building, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairpersonship of Secretary(Culture) to discuss setting up of Mission Secretariat and modalities for carrying out Cultural Mapping activities. Further, necessary assistance of State Govt. machinery (District and local administration) may be taken for maintenance of security, law & order and smooth & successfully conducting the proposed programmes.
