Subject: Instructions for organizations regarding submission of application/documents for Renewal of Financial Assistance for Promotion of Guru-Shishya Parampara (Repertory Grant).

As per the scheme guidelines of 'Financial Assistance for Promotion of Guru-Shishya Parampara (Repertory Grant)', those grantees who are already receiving the Grant, would be recommended for renewal only when they stage at least two productions during the financial year. Out of this two, at least one production must be a new production i.e. which has not been staged earlier.

- 2. It has, however been observed that some organizations which are getting grant under Cultural Function Production Grant (CFPG) are showing these productions under Financial Assistance for Promotion of Guru-Shishya Parampara (Repertory Grant) also which is in violation of letter and spirit of the Scheme guidelines and is therefore not permissible. The organizations applying for Renewal of grant under the scheme will, henceforth be required to produce a certificate to this effect at the time of personal interaction with the Expert Committee members.
- 3. It has also been noted that some organizations with a view to get financial assistance for maximum number of 18 Artists have been changing their activity area from music/dance etc. to theatre/drama thus adversely affecting their core area of competence. The Ministry has taken cognizance of the matter and it has been decided that any such change on part of these organizations will not be permissible.
