9. Whether age and Educational Qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees.	--
10. Period of probation, if any	Six months
11. Tenure	Normally on contract for a period of three years. In case, the period of three years or any extension is going beyond the age of superannuation then, continuation beyond the age of superannuation will be with specific approval of the Government.
