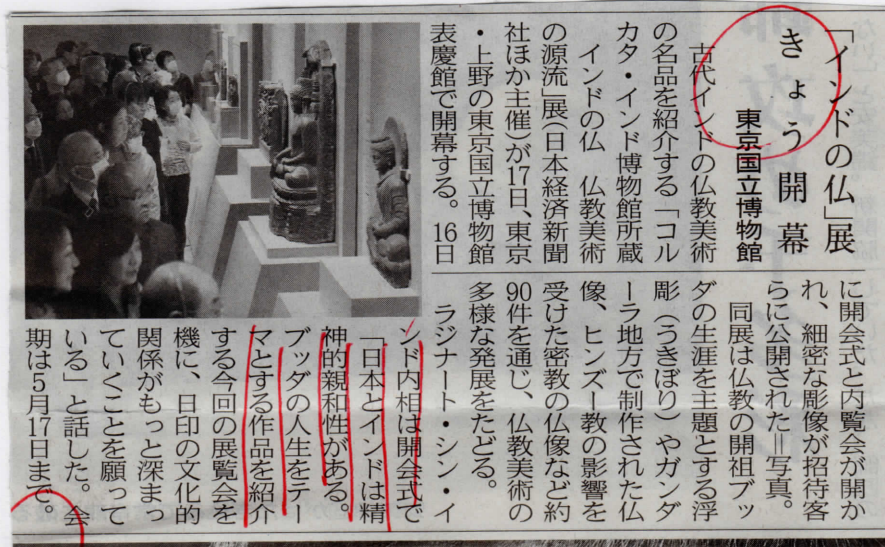
“Special Exhibition on India’s Buddhist Arts Opens Today”

Special exhibition which showcases India’s Buddhist arts will open today at Tokyo National Museum in Ueno. The Nikkei Inc. organizes the exhibition. At the exhibition, 90 fine pieces of Buddhist art from Kolkata India Museum will be exhibited. Opening ceremony and special preview event were held on 16<sup>th</sup> March.
