

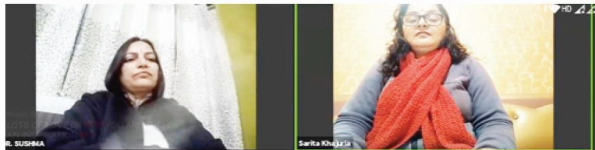
Sahitya Akademi organizes Webline literature series 'Nari Chetna'
