The NGMA family is deeply saddened with the demise of Shri Charles Correa, one of the most eminent Indian Architects of his generation, on 16th June 2015.

His work has had an enormous influence on India's post-independence urban landscape. His work is reflective, often provocative and always profound mediation on India's cities, the culmination of a lifetime of studying the urban landscape. I would like to mention one of his quotes, "Our habitat is not created in a vacuum. It is the compulsive expression of beliefs and aspirations that are central to own life".
