Effigy of Khalash:

Wood: Community- Khalash: Provenance –Kaffiristhan, Hindukush, Afghanistan: Accession No: 11813.

In Afghanistan, at the extremity of the Hindukush, there are a few small permanent villages of Khalash kaffirs. They maintain their own traditional religion although surrounded by Muslims, own language anda complex system of ritual and belief. The Khalash are one of the most remarkable cultures in the world, with a population of just over 3,000.

It was collected by eminent Anthropologist Dr. B.S. Guha within a scientific expedition in 1929.
